Position Description:

- Generate analytic models, and enable analysts to exploit DHS and IC data holdings.
- Establish advanced analysis and data visualization methodologies, models, and tools to derive intelligence outcomes and impacts.
- Establish data visualization concepts to better represent insights.
- Assist in establishing capability to examine voluminous data sources.
- Assist in applying innovative and big data-driven problem-solving skills to analytic and operational elements.
- Provide services related to data visualization and communication of complex quantitative concepts to non-technical audiences.
- Assist in mission data projects within DHS and with other US Government partners, as appropriate.
- Review and revise the Risk Dashboard known as the Multi-faceted International-Threat Detection and Analysis System (MIDAS) capabilities and risk methodology.
 - Automate the data import and export.
 - Validate current risk scoring algorithms.
 - Validate and refine unclassified countermeasures to ensure effectiveness and precision.
 - o Identify and obtain additional, relevant potential risk indicator (PRI) information sources to enhance MIDAS' risk assessment and identification capabilities.
 - Add visualization enhancements, such as to the user interface and the display of foreign national photographs.
 - Provide support to a range of website, graphics, audio, video and other multimedia. Provide graphic content for all-source intelligence and information products, brochures, handouts, presentations, posters, and other materials. Assist with the design and/or maintenance associated with

classified and unclassified websites (SharePoint). Develop interactive graphics and assist analysts and other personnel in conceptualizing and designing informative, effective graphics and multimedia content to enhance the analytic and information mission

- o Enable direct connectivity to ISMS and other sources of data.
- o Increase accessibility to MIDAS from external networks.
- Enhance MIDAS which includes modification or addition of datasets, DHS forms, and ISMS database to collect and analyze additional foreign access risk indicators. These enhancements will allow MIDAS to analyze six DHS forms, ISMS data sets, CONCUR official travel reporting, OCIO spear phishing reports, I&A foreign disclosure data, and OCRSO critical resources data. Successful ingestion of these datasets will result in an estimated 56 additional foreign access risk indicators for analysis by MIDAS v2.0. The ingest of these data sets should result in: i. Instantaneous calculation and display of the top 10-20 foreign nationals with the highest risk factors. ii. Instantaneous calculation and display of the top 10-20 employees categorized as highest risk based on exposure (contact/visits/travel). iii. Ability to immediately produce reports based on individual, country, organization, activity, or risk type.
